(1) TOOLS AND MATERIALS REQUIRED

- ❖ DRILL AND APPROPRIATE BITS
- ❖ PENCIL
- ❖ PLIERS
- ❖ ADJUSTABLE WRENCH
- ❖ WIRING SUPPLIES AS REQUIRED BY ELECTRICAL CODE

Attention:

Before assembling your lighting fixture, please read the instructions. If you feel you do not have sufficient experience, refer to a do-it-yourself wiring handbook or have your fixture installed by a qualified electrician.

(2) GENERAL

1. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
2. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electrical code. If you are unfamiliar with methods of installing electrical wiring. Secure the services of a qualified licensed electrician.
3. This fixture is intended to be mounted onto a wall or to a standard 4" x 2-1/4" deep metal octagon outlet box the box must be directly supported by the building structure. If no outlet box is present, a back plate is provided for mounting the fixture to a wall.
4. Before commencing with the installation, *disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker* or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock or risk of fire.
5. Save these **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS** and refer to them when additions to or changes in the fixture configuration are made.
6. Do not install this fixture in hazardous locations.
7. Do not install any fixture assembly closer than 6 inches from any curtain or similar combustible material.

The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care, are factors that cannot be built into any product. The person(s) caring for and operating the fixture must supply these factors.

(3) UNPACKING THE FIXTURE

Check the contents of the Box:

- ❖ MOUNTING HARDWARE PACKAGE
- ❖ FIXTURE ASSEMBLY
- ❖ 35W /GU-10*1

(4) PREPARE THE FIXTURE

Insure that the circuit breaker is turned off.

1. Insert the supplied 35w GU-10 bulb into the lamp socket.
2. Remove the 4 screws located on the sides of the canopy.
3. Position the mounting bracket assembly onto the surface of the wall and mark the attachment holes with a pencil.
4. Remove the mounting bracket and drill the holes for the placement of the wall anchors accordingly.
5. Reposition the mounting bracket and secure to the wall with supplied screws.
6. Attach the fixture canopy over the mounting bracket and secure with the four screws.
7. **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS** -This lamp has a polarized plug (one blade wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.
8. Restore electricity and check the operation of your new lighting fixture.

CAUTION:

- *Do Not use Bulbs Exceeding Maximum Wattage of 35W, As Per Caution Label.*
- *Ensure that the Fitting is Cool and Switched off, Before Changing the Bulb.*
- *Do Not Touch the Bulb while fixture is in operation.*
- *Do Not Operate the Lighting Fixture close to any Combustible Material.*
